

Park and Recreation Questions

- What time do the parks open/close?

All parks open at 8:00 a.m. and close at 10:00 p.m. unless otherwise posted or by special permission from the City Council or City Manager.

- Who do I contact to reserve one of the parks for a day?

Kingsford City Hall can be contacted at (906) 774-3526 to inquire about park use.

- How do I reserve a pavilion at one of the parks?

To reserve a pavilion, a form will need to be completed that specifies the date and time of the event, as well as the location of the pavilion being requested. The form can be obtained at City Hall (305 S. Carpenter Avenue) between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

- Which parks have pavilions available for reservation and what amenities are available at each location?

Pavilions can be reserved at Cowboy Lake and the Menominee River Park. A gazebo can also be reserved at Gazebo Park (located on Woodward Avenue), but there are no amenities available at this location. The amenities available at the Cowboy Lake and Menominee River pavilions are as follows:

- How do I reserve a baseball, football, or soccer field?

A park use permit application will have to be completed to reserve an athletic field. The permit application can be obtained at City Hall (305 S. Carpenter Avenue) between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

- What are the fees associated with the use of pavilions and/or athletic fields?

There are no fees associated with the use of any of the park pavilions or the gazebo located at Gazebo Park. There are also no fees associated with the use of any of the athletic fields, however, there is a \$100 refundable deposit that is required when utilizing the Kingsford Commemorative Soccer Field located on Evergreen Court.
