

City Hall

- What are the office hours at City Hall?
The City Hall office is open Monday through Friday from 7:30am to 4:30pm. There is a drop box located at the rear entrance of the building that can be utilized for making payments after hours.
- What are the phone numbers to other local utility departments?

- Does the City of Kingsford require dogs to be licensed?
Yes. Michigan state law requires all dogs in the state to be licensed.
- How do I obtain a dog license?
Dog licenses can be obtained at Kingsford City Hall between the dates of November 1st and March 1st. After March 1st, dog licenses can be purchased through the Dickinson County Offices. Proof of the dog's current rabies vaccination is required to purchase a dog license. The rabies certificate is obtained from your veterinarian upon vaccination, and lists the rabies tag number and expiration date of the vaccination. The fee is \$20.00.
- Do I need a permit from the city to operate a business within city limits?
The City does not require any special permits to operate a business within the city limits at this time.
