

ELECTIONS

- Where do I go to vote?

Precinct #1 is designated to vote at City Hall (305 S. Carpenter Avenue) and Precinct #2 is designated to vote at the Public Works Building (1500 Carter Drive). Please contact the Kingsford City Hall at (906) 774-3526 x. 6 if there are questions regarding which precinct a resident is designated to vote at.

- How do I obtain an absentee ballot to vote?

An application for an absentee ballot must be completed and returned to Kingsford City Hall and the application will be mailed to your registered home address. You may use the Statue of Liberty/Flag voter specific dropbox or the other dropbox. You must present proof of identification if absentee ballot is requested in person (or sign an affidavit). The application can be obtained in person at City Hall or mailed by calling City Hall at (906) 774-3526 x. 6. The City of Kingsford maintains a permanent absent voter list and you may request to be on the list either verbally/e-mail/faxed request or by checking the box on the absent voter application. If you are on the permanent absent voter list, an absent voter *application* will be mailed to you each election. If you would like to receive an absent voter ballot for that election, you must sign and return the absent voter application in order to receive a ballot. A ballot will not be automatically sent to you if you do not first submit an absent voter application. Once the completed application is received, the absentee ballot will be mailed or picked up at City Hall upon request. The signed ballot must be returned to City Hall no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
